Reconciliation	A sacrament in the church that helps bring us closer to God and each other when we have done wrong.
Confession	Admit to doing or saying something wrong.
Conscience	Part of us that helps us to know right from wrong and what makes us feel guilty when we do wrong.
Penance	An action or prayer to show that you are sorry for something – a way of putting things right.
Consequence	A result of an action or situation
Repentance	Showing that you are sorry for something.
Penitent	A person making the act of penance.
Absolution	When God has forgiven you for everything you've done wrong and you can make a fresh start.
