To minister his grace.

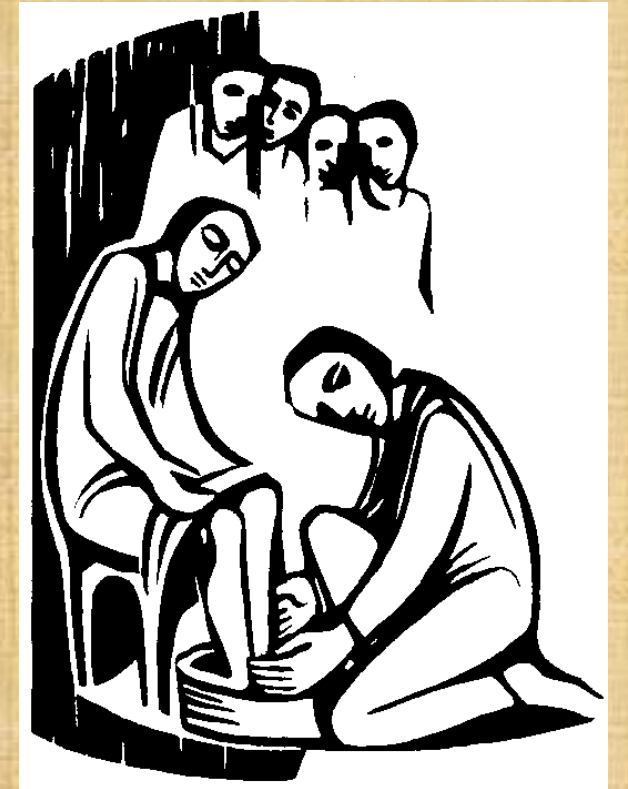
No work too hard for him,

Whom shall I send?

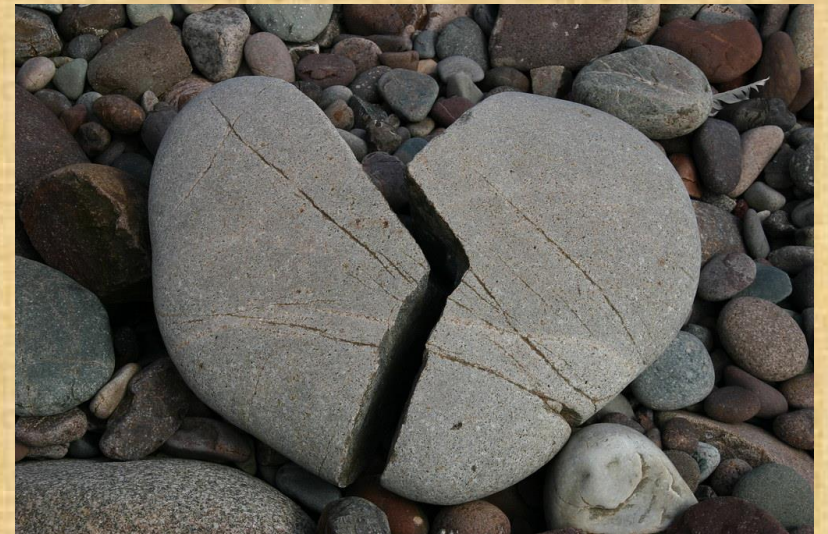
