Sorry	When you realise that you have made a mistake and want to make things right
Forgive	To decide not to be angry or upset with someone if the have hurt you.
Choices	We choose between one thing or another.
Sin	Sin is something bad that we do – even though we know we shouldn't do it. It is also a sin if we do not do something good even though we know we should.
Consequences	What happens because of a choice on we have made
Examination of Conscience	When we think about things we have done wrong, or times when we did not do good things.
