#### Key Vocabulary

<b>Rules</b>	Rules are instructions that tell us what to do
<b>Sorry</b>	When you realise that you have made a mistake and want to make things right
<b>Forgive</b>	To decide not to be angry or upset with someone if they have hurt you.
<b>Choices</b>	We choose between one thing or another.
<b>Sin</b>	Sin is something bad that we do – even though we know we shouldn't do it. It is also a sin if we do not do something good even though we know we should.
<b>Consequences</b>	What happens because of a choice on we have made
<b>Examination of Conscience</b>	When we think about things we have done wrong, or times when we did not do good things.
<b>Other vocabulary</b>	Care, safe, right, wrong, make-up
