

Key Vocabulary	
Contrition	Contrition is a feeling of responsibility for something you've done wrong or something you've failed to do.
Absolution	When God has forgiven you for everything you've done wrong and you can make a fresh start.
Sacrament of Reconciliation	A sacrament in the church that helps bring us closer to God and each other when we have done wrong.
Examination of Conscience	When we think about things we have done wrong, or times when we did not do good things.
Sin	Sin is something bad that we do – even though we know we shouldn't do it. It is also a sin if we do not do something good even though we know we should.
Penance	An action or prayer to show that you are sorry for something – a way of putting things right
Confession	Admit to doing or saying something wrong.
