Key Vocabulary

| Ash Wednesday | Lent begins on Ash Wednesday. People go to church and the priest makes a cross with ashes on each persons forehead. |

| Lent | Lent is the 40 day season to prepare for Easter. In Lent we GIVE (charity), we ACT (eg fasting, make changes), we PRAY. The colour of the season is purple |
| Cross | Jesus died on a cross. A cross is a symbol of Christianity. |
| Crucifix | A crucifix is a cross with an image of Jesus on it. |
| Easter candle | The Easter candle is also called the Paschal candle. It is a large, white candle used in church. A new Pascha candle is blessed and lit every year at Easter, and is used throughout the Easter season and then throughout the year on special occasions. |
| Easter new life | At Easter, Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, and his new life from God. It is the most important feast in the Christian church – even more important than Christmas. |
