Key Vocabulary

Choice	We choose between one thing or another.
Disappointed	When you do not get what you had hoped for.
Forgive	To decide not to be angry or upset with someone if they have hurt you.
Rules	Rules are instructions that tell us what to do
Sorry	When you realise that you have made a mistake and want to make things right
Other vocabulary	Happy, sad, right, wrong, feeling, love

Big Questions
Why should we be sorry?
How do we feel when we make good choices (and wrong choices)
