What I should know already

Lent, the opportunity to turn towards what is good in preparation for Easter.

Key Vocabulary	
Ash Wednesday	Lent begins on Ash Wednesday. People go to church and the priest makes a cross with ashes on each persons forehead.
Holy Week	Holy Week is the most important week in the Church's Year. It starts with Palm Sunday. Through Holy Week we remember when we remember The Last Supper, the Passion and Death of Jesus, and his Resurrection.
Easter – new life	At Easter, Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, and his new life from God. It is the most important feast in the Christian church – even more important that Christmas.
Resurrection	Resurrection means: someone who really died, gets a new life from God
Self-giving	Thinking of others before ourselves.
Almsgiving	Being charitable and loving.
Fasting	Giving up/going without food or drink
Other vocabulary	Courage, prayer, sorrowful mysteries
