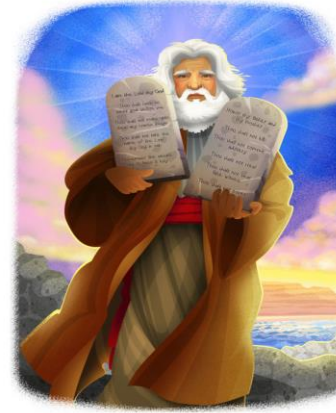
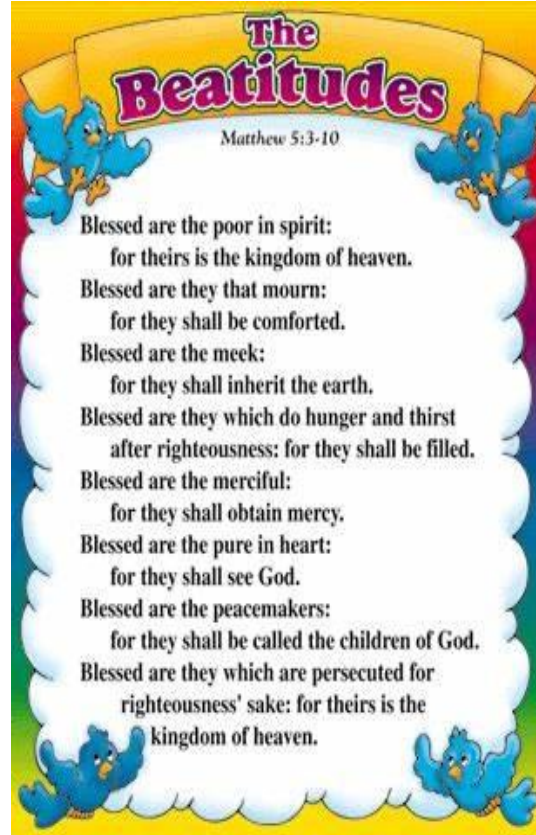
## Reconciliation: Commandments enable Christians to be free and responsible

### What I should know already

### Key Vocabulary

<b>Freedom</b>	Being able to think, do or say as we want.
<b>Responsibility</b>	Something that is your job/ duty to deal with.
<b>Commandments</b>	God gave 10 Commandments to the people of Israel - these are rules for living well together.
<b>Beatitudes</b>	The Beatitudes are 8 blessings that Jesus taught that show us how to live good and happy lives.
<b>Reconciliation</b>	A sacrament in the church that helps bring us closer to God and each other when we have done wrong.
