Eucharist	The celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of being at one with God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, as well as being at one with each other.
Communion	Communion means 'being at one with'. It is similar in meaning to words uch as relationship, empathy, unity, union, one with.
Community	The Eucharist calls us to strengthen our community – do we help each other, do we forgive each other?
Unity	Being united and joined together.
