Key Vocabulary

Eucharist	The celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of being at one with God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, as well as being at one with each other.
Communion	Communion means 'being at one with'. It is similar in meaning to words such as relationship, empathy, unity, union, one with.
Community	The Eucharist calls us to strengthen our community – do we help each other, do we forgive each other?
Unity	Being united and joined together.

For as in one body we have many members, and not all members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another.
