What I should know already

Lent: a time to grow more like Jesus and look forward to Easter

Key Vocabulary

| Lent | Lent is the 40 day season to prepare for Easter. In Lent we GIVE (charity), we ACT (eg fasting, make changes), we PRAY. The colour of the season is purple. |
| Ash Wednesday | Lent begins on Ash Wednesday. People go to church and the priest makes a cross with ashes on each persons forehead. |
| Good Friday | The day that Jesus died. |
| Easter Sunday | The day when Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. It is the most important feast in the Christian church – even more important than Christmas. |
| Alleluia | Alleluia means 'Praise the Lord'. Catholics don't say 'Alleluia' during Lent. Catholics only start to say Alleluia again on Easter Sunday |
| Stations of the Cross | During Lent, many people pray the Stations of the Cross. The word station means stopping place on the way to Calvary – remembering Jesus journey to Calvary. |
| Resurrection | Resurrection means: someone who really died, gets a new life from God |
| Other vocabulary | change, seasons, spring growth, hosanna, cross |
