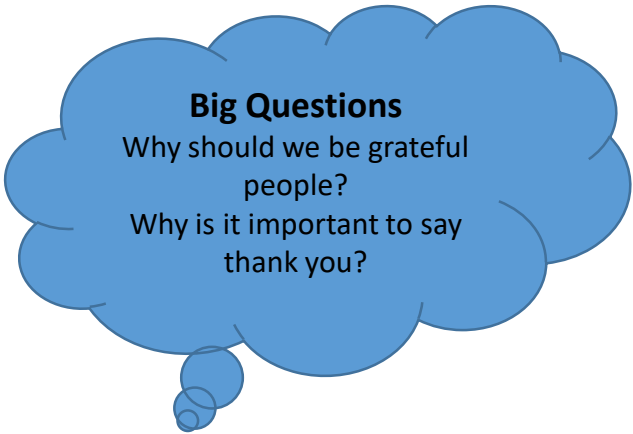

### Key Vocabulary

<b>Thanksgiving</b>	Being grateful for what we have been given. The Greek word for thanksgiving is 'Eucharist'. Eucharist is another name for Holy Mass.
<b>Eucharist</b>	The Eucharist or Holy Communion is the meeting point where God gives himself to us as food. We receive the Body of Christ and become part of his Body – the Church. Eucharist is a Greek word that means 'Thanksgiving'. We give thanks to God, most of all for the gift of Jesus, his Son.
<b>Eucharistic Prayer</b>	The priest takes the place of Jesus and says special prayers over the bread and wine so that they become the Body and Blood of Christ.
