## Key Vocabulary

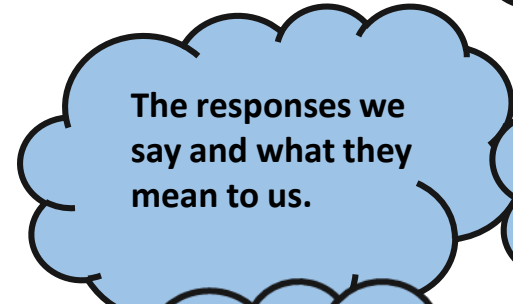
<b>Bible and Sacred Scripture</b>	Bible comes from the Greek word ‘Biblos’ which means ‘book’. The Bible is the most important book for Christians because it tells us how much God loves us and through the Sacred Scriptures in the Bible God speaks directly to us. When we read the Bible, God is speaking directly to us. The Bible has two parts, the Old Testament and the New Testament.
<b>Old Testament</b>	The Old Testament is the first part of the Bible before Jesus was born. It starts with creation and tells us how people got to know God and ends with the coming of a new heaven and earth.
<b>New Testament</b>	The New Testament is the second part of the Bible and tells us all about Jesus Christ and the start of the early Christian church. It includes the four Gospels.
<b>Gospels</b>	The story of Jesus Christ and his teachings told by the four Gospel writers, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
<b>Respect</b>	Caring for something or someone.



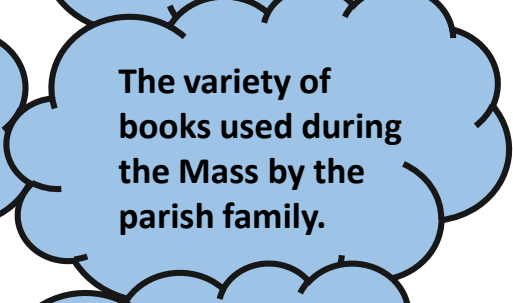

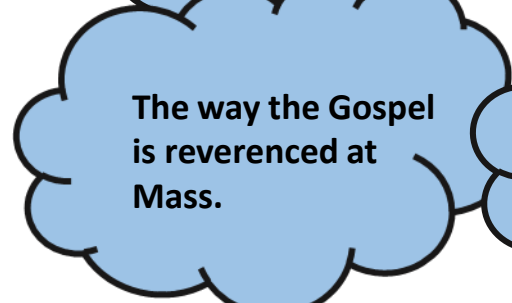

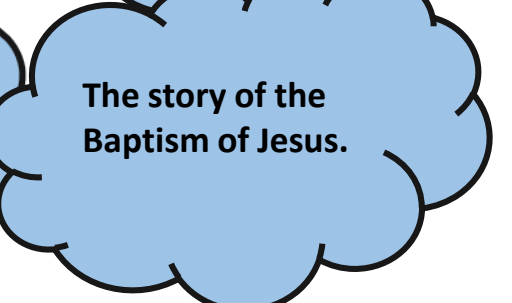
