Reading in Year 2

Your child will be given a set of books and a reading diary to bring home and read on a set reading day. They will need to keep their reading diary in their book bags and bring this to school on their reading day. The children will also have lots of opportunities to read and enjoy books throughout the week at school and at home.

Star of the Week

Each Friday one child's name will be picked to be the Star of the Week. A certificate will be sent home to acknowledge this and inform parents. In class, there is also the Recognition Board with a weekly class focus. The children will aim to get their name on the board during the week. This will be rewarded with a dip in the treat box on Friday. Sticker rewards and 'dips' in the Golden Box are also rewards for recognition of positive behaviour and going above and beyond in a variety of aspects of school life.

General Reminders

 is dressed appropriately on this day.
- Any letters or reply slips, which need to be returned, can be put in your child's book bag. The children are encouraged to check them each morning and give things in after the register.
